Rabbi Moshe Pinchuk is a graduate of the Yeshivat Hesder program where he was both student and Ram. He was the founding Rosh Kollel Torah Mitzion in Melbourne. He founded the Doresh Zion Institute for the study of Talmud Yerushalmi. He has published articles in diverse areas of Judaism as well as in mathematics. Hassidah (nee Peri) Pinchuk is a graduate of Matan, she holds a B.A. in Jewish History and Yiddish from the Hebrew University, and an M.A. in Educational Counseling, also from the Hebrew University. She was an educator and lecturer in the Midrasha of the Jewish Quarter and currently works for the World Bnei Akiva movement in charge of personal supervision of the movement's shlichim, and the convener of the Beit Midrash for Women project in the Department of Spiritual Services in the Diaspora of the World Zionist Organization. The Pinchuks currently live in Ramat Bet Shemesh with their five children.
