**YTC Melava Malka**—The annual Yeshiva Toras

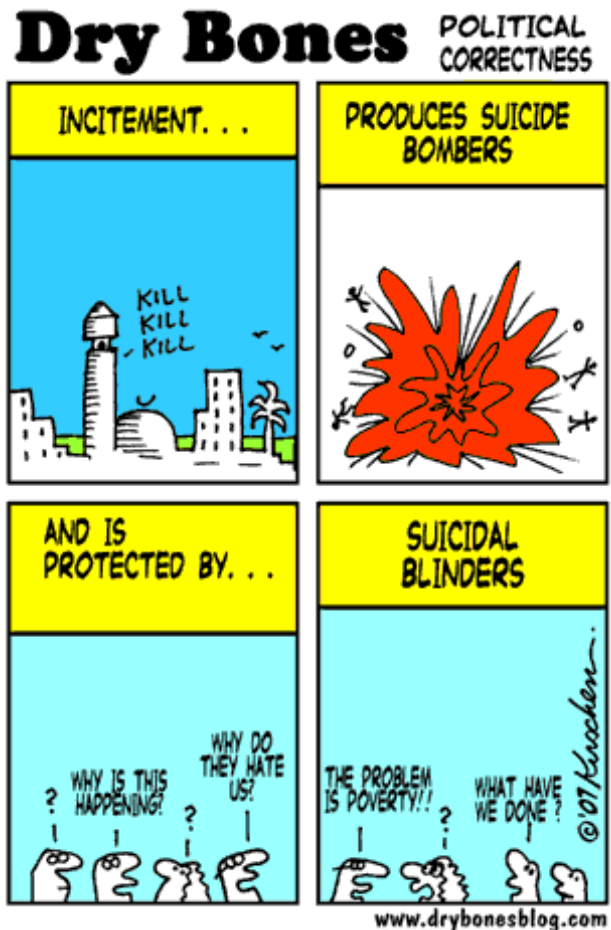
