#### Community Events

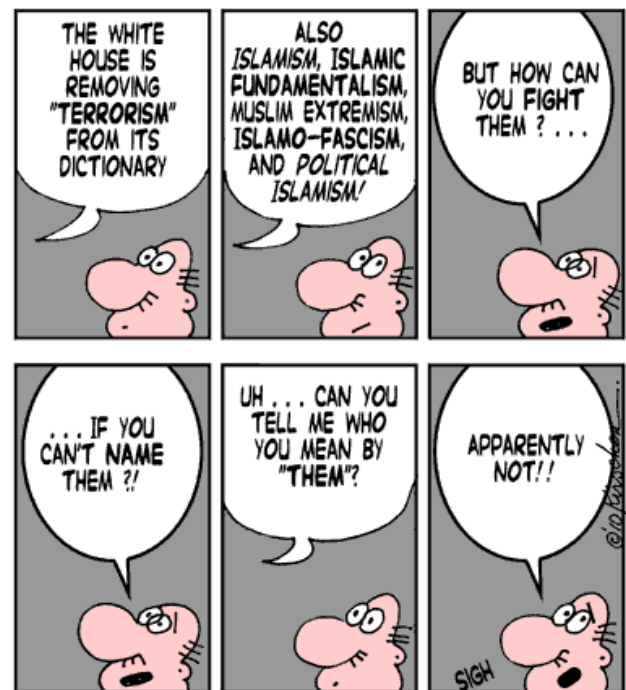
